# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## ON SUNDAYS

- What can I expect? The service usually lasts about an hour, but sometimes might go a little longer. Coffee & tea are available in the café before and after the service. You are welcome to stay and chat.
- What happens for children? All children stay in the service for the first 20 minutes, then go to one of the following:

**Parents room: under 2 years** available for parents with small children, or stay and play in the lounge. No supervision is provided. An audio feed is available in the parents room.

**The Garden: 2-4 years old** through the café to Daystar Child Care Centre next door.

The Jungle: primary/intermediate school. School years 1–8 meet downstairs in the lower lounge.

- What about in the holidays? We have activity packs available for the children during school holidays.
- Where can I park my car? If the church carpark is full, there is more parking available in the carpark around the corner, behind the Bank of Baroda. Entry via Dominion Road.
